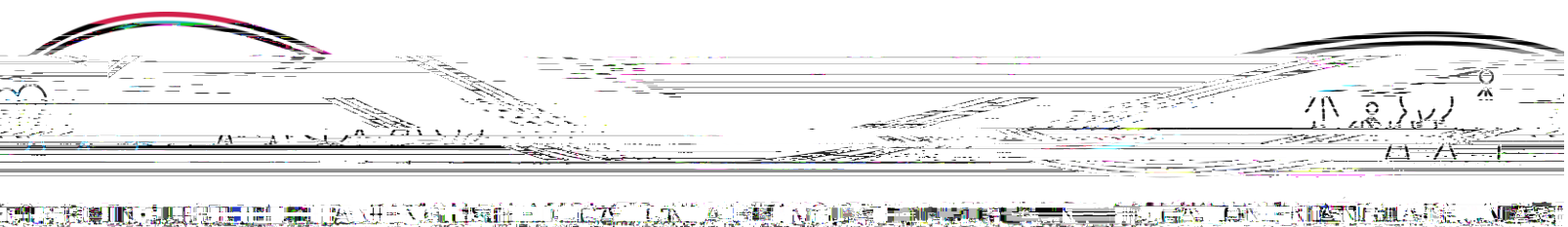

WHEREAS the CSS de Laval has negotiated a reduced network maintenance fee of \$175.00 per kilometre;

WHEREAS the total annual cost to the SWLSB will be of approximately \$16,000.00, before taxes;
